LESSON OBJECTIVES

AIM	be able to use the language and test strategies to develop the skills students need to analyze photos and reject tricky choices that are almost correct.
FOCUS	language strategies (nouns, verbs, locations, facts, interpretation); test strategies (similar sound, prepositions, inaccurate description, different context)

Tuesday	Analyzing Photos (Photos 1 and 2)
Wednesday	Analyzing Photos (Photos 3 and 4)
Thursday	Analyzing Photos (Photos 5 and 6)
Friday	Analyzing Photos (Photos 7 and 8)
Monday	Strategy Practice / Picture-based Sentence Construction

Note: The progress of the lessons depends on the level of the students inside the class.

WHAT CAN I LEARN?

The student can increase his/her vocabulary by identifying words in the photo which includes things that he/she sees and need to be described and also the people, what they are doing and the location they are in. Students can improve their paraphrasing skill by constructing sentences using one picture. By paraphrasing, students can apply grammar rules taught during the first week and phrases that can make the sentence longer.

CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES

Identifying 5 nouns, verbs and location as a group
Constructing factual sentences about the photo
Identifying statements that might be true about the photo
Application of Test Strategies
True or False Game

SELF STUDY TIPS

Review the picture and create as many true English sentences about the photo as possible. Listen to the speakers' intonation, stress and the difference between sounds. Review correct answers and make sure you know why an answer is correct or incorrect.
