#### WHAT CAN I LEARN?

In Unit 9, the student can learn how to share about problems with technology using questions within sentences. He/she can practice describing how things work using separable phrasal verbs and asking for help with the use of technology. Giving different opinions and asking someone to agree with you can also be learned with the use of commonly used expressions in given situations. In addition, the student can learn more about email scams by reading articles about it. Finally, he/she can start planning and writing an article about protecting personal information, which is a very good way to improve his/her writing skill. In Unit 10, the student can learn how to talk about news with the use of time expressions. The student can also practice on talking about social life using the present perfect with "already, still, and yet". Asking for a favor politely and agreeing to a request will also be practiced and learned. Reading and writing movie reviews will be done as activities to focus more on improving those skills.
