WHAT CAN I LEARN?

The student can discover interesting facts about other countries when it comes to homes and buildings, thus enabling him/her to make comparisons and contrasts. In addition, he/she is stimulated to come up with reasons, both positive and negative, to justify his/her choices or thoughts, allowing him/her to speak at length, use richer vocabulary and make rational ideas. Throughout this unit, he/she can get more familiar with the vocabulary for rooms and buildings and engage more with others as he/she can extend his/her talk with the newly learned adjectives. The adverbs of degree (e.g very, quite) to be learned can, likewise, help him/her sound more natural with the employment of the pronunciation skill in terms of linking consonant sounds with vowel sounds.
