WHAT CAN I LEARN?

The student can improve his/her skills in identifying and giving descriptions using the English language. He/She will acquire the proper vocabulary in describing animals while being able to listen for specific details and definitions. By using a diagram, he/she will also practice explaining the meaning of new or difficult words in groups. In order to aid him/her in handling conversations and discussions, the student can acquire techniques on how to properly introduce a topic and use questions in a talk to help the listeners gain a better understanding about it. He/she will also be able to effectively use pauses in a discourse and be aware of the silent consonants since native speakers do not always pronounce every consonant when they are in a group.
