WHAT CAN I LEARN?

The student will get a grip and infer the meanings of obscure words by recognizing and taking advantage of context clues that may appear within the same or in a preceding sentence. He/she will be able to employ and utilize appropriate expressions for disagreement even in an informal setting. Besides, the learner will learn focus words that contain new information and are usually the last content word in a sentence, clause, or phrase. As he/she presents about his/her future plans in class, the usage of Will and Be Going To will be encouraged, as well as the contractions commonly applied with Will. Finally, the student will be able to use signal words and expressions to help the listener understand the order of his/her plans while being able to make predictions, promises, and to talk about things he/she is certain about in the future.
