WHAT CAN I LEARN?

The student will discuss his/her opinions on the accuracy of first impressions. Along with that, to broaden the student's understanding of the matter, he/she will listen to a lecture about first impressions and summarize the lecture by taking notes of important details. Also, the student will learn to make inferences about first impression of someone in a story that her/his classmates will share in the class. In addition, he/she will compare and contrast ideas of two researchers on first impressions and eventually be able to formulate tips about making first impressions. And for vocabulary skill, the student will learn to guess the meaning of an unfamiliar word by being able to recognize the part of speech of the word and suffixes. For the grammar, the student will review his/her knowledge of auxiliary verbs and how to make contractions with auxiliary verbs. Finally, the student will use the ideas and information that he/she could gather and be able to give a short talk about first impressions.
